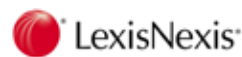

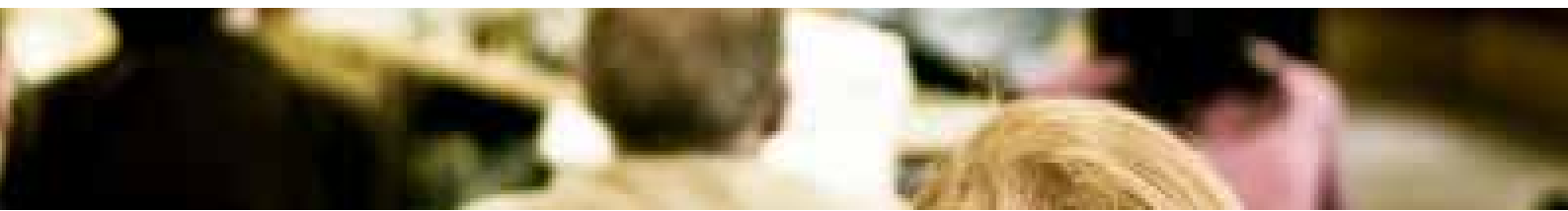
## THE LAWTECH AWARDS:
